DOGS (FOULING OF LAND)

ORDER 1998

The Dartford Borough Council (in this Order called "the council") hereby make the following order:

1. The land described in the Schedule below being land in the area of the council which is land to which the Dogs (Fouling of Land) Act 1996 applies, is hereby designated for the purposes of that Act.

2. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Dartford Dogs (Fouling of Land) ORDER 1998 and shall come into force on 16 October 1998.

SCHEDULE

LAND DESIGNATED BY DESCRIPTION

All land within the Borough of Dartford to which the public have access (with or without payment) and is open to the air on at least one side subject to the following exemptions:-

- 1) Carriageways with a speed limit of more than 40 mph and land running alongside.
- 2) Land used for agriculture or woodland.
- 3) Land which is marshland, moor or heath.
- 4) Common land.
- 5) Private land where the landowner allows their own or other dogs to foul that land.
